Néstor Kirchner's presidency is coming to an end, leaving a legacy of mismanagement and corruption behind.

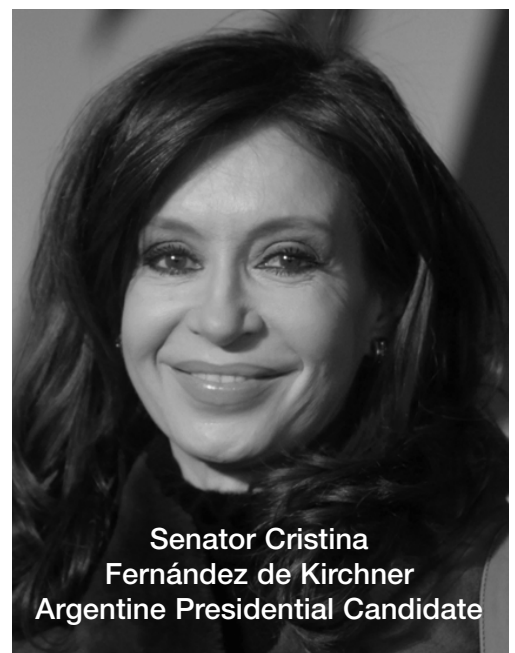
Argentina continues to cozy up to Hugo Chavez and Venezuela; recently representatives of Venezuela's state owned oil company flew \$800,000 in mystery cash into Argentina.

And worse, even though Argentina could afford to honor its foreign debts, in 2005 President Kirchner changed the rules and repudiated \$20 billion owed to global debt holders, including more than \$3 billion that affects millions of Americans.

If elected, presidential candidate Senator Cristina Fernández de Kirchner should crack down on corruption, halt the exodus of foreign investment — and most importantly — repay Argentina's debts in order to gain the trust and respect of the international community.
